Although we will not have any family coming to see us this Christmas due to travel restrictions, we will be having two Korean students stay with us for the Christmas break as they are not able to return to Korea. Please pray that Jinki and Bastien and our family will be blessed as we spend this time together, celebrating the birth of the Messiah and the coming of God to dwell among us.

Next semester will bring some big changes for Carol as she will transition from filling in for the 6th grade teacher who was ill, to being a full time 7th and 8th grade language arts teacher. Although it is a somewhat daunting assignment for her, she looks forward to teaching students she had when they were in 5th and 6th grade and also teaching Hannah's class again next year if all goes well! Please pray for her as she plans the next semester and takes on the added responsibilities of having her own classroom.

Rob continues to focus his attention on assisting Joshua Chan with the Lahu Living Word (LLW) Project, focusing on developing the Biblical Leadership Training (BLT) to help equip the indigenous village pastors to preach, teach, disciple, counsel and shepherd the believers in the village churches and bring the gospel to new areas. Rob's new position with Family connections Foundation (FCF) is the Leadership Development Coordinator for the LLW Project.

Rob's role of organizing, planning, developing and coordinating the BLT program for LLW has been a great blessing to Joshua Chan and his wife. While having lunch at Joshua's home recently, Joshua said to Rob, "I'm finally getting these things done and in order. I have been praying to the Lord to send help for years, and you (Rob) are the answer to our prayers ... Hallelujah!" What a blessing to be a blessing!

One common challenge facing most village pastors is the necessity of working part-time while serving in the ministry: bi-vocational pastors are the norm in the villages. Rob has been able to coordinate and plan with Joshua Chan how we could invite other believers to assist these pastors and evangelists in developing businesses to help support their families working part-time while serving the church part-time. - A new student boarder to stay in our extra room in our house.
 - Praise the Lord we will have 2 students stay with us over the December break that we were not expecting. Also, we have confirmed that Lukas will stay with us beginning next year in July and stay the entire 2021-2022 school year, and maybe for several years as he will be a freshman next year. We also are talking with a family in Singapore who would like their son John to stay for the 2021-2022 school year as well. This would be great to help us meet our financial need and be able to serve these families serving the Lord in southeast Asia.
- Carol as she fills in for a sixth grade teacher who is out for the semester due to health issues. This is Hannah's class which Carol has worked with in the last two years. She knows and loves these students well and is grateful to have returned from America just in time to meet this need. Please pray for the teacher, Anna, who is from the UK, not to lose heart but recover fully and be able to return to her work.
 - Another praise as Anna is feeling much better and feels up to taking on her full responsibilities next semester. Please pray for continued strength for her.
- Guidance and wisdom as Rob serves with the LLW team and develops the training modules for the Biblical Leadership Training (BLT) with the main theme of "Be Like Jesus."
 - The LLW Advisory Board is favorable to revising the BLT training curriculum to follow the theme of "Be Like Jesus." We will cover 6 themes each year, 1 week of training per year on each theme: Be Like Jesus in Personal Discipline, Understanding the Scripture, Teaching, Preaching, Building the Church and Leading the Church. Each year will build on the last training and explore the theme more deeply, with great emphasis on practical application.
- For the funding to come together so we can start the translation project in the Lahu language for the Good Soil *Story of Hope* resources.
 - We now have a spot on our webpage where people can give to this project: Click <u>TRANSLATION PROJECT</u> We continue to pray the Lord will send the funding so we can provide the resources to encourage the Lahu churches in desperate need of teaching materials for the children and youth.
- Our dear adult children in the States that they would continue to grow nearer to God and see His goodness in every aspect of their lives.
 - We are grateful we can stay in touch with our adult children and encourage them to look to the Lord as they face the challenges of life. Only the Lord can give us the right perspective on any situation so that we can endure through it and grow better, not become bitter.

• Carol as she begins teaching 7th and 8th grade language arts in January. Her biggest challenges will be the organizational and technical side as she plans lessons and learns how to fully implement Google classroom. Please also pray for her as she

seeks to link literature to biblical principles and helps the students to make connections between what they are learning and the truths of God's word.

- Guidance and wisdom as Rob develops the training modules for the Biblical Leadership Training (BLT) with the main theme of "Be Like Jesus." He will be focusing on the Biblical family, providing training and counseling to church leaders who were married as Buddhists who now want to get "re-married" as Chrisitans with a Biblical perspective on marriage and the home.
- Insight and understanding to develop an Appendix for the Lahu Christian Correspondence Course (LCCC) that will focus on the basics of Bible reading and interpretation, as well as establishing the mindset of being a life-long follower and learner of Jesus. The completion of the LCCC is not the end to their Biblical learning, it is only the start of life-long journey of following and serving the Messiah Jesus.
- Funding for the various projects we are promoting to provide investment capital to BLT graduates to start small businesses, to meet their financial needs and allow more time to serve the members of their churches and communities.
- James stays focused on his studies and does his work with excellence, *even though* he does not see the value of such studies at this time. The main goal is not to collect knowledge of various subjects, but rather, it is to build character that learns the value of discipline, delayed rewards, integrity, honesty and excellence.

We are so thankful for you who have partnered with us, making it possible for us to serve the Lord in Thailand for the last two and half years - hard to believe it's been that long! May the Lord bless your year with His presence, His power, and His hope that brings peace and joy in every and all circumstances.

Many of these church leaders desire to be better trained to teach and preach the word, and lead their churches. There is need for literacy training so they can complete the LCCC 10-part training and the BLT for those desiring more training.
